

Sand Scrapers



Roylco's **Sand Scrapers** are durable, easy-to-use sand tools for children. Explore lines and experiment with angles to create unique patterns in the sand.

Here are some basic techniques:

- For a clear surface, smooth out the sand with a rolling pin, ruler or Roylco's **R5452 Flat Paint Scrapers**.
- Scrape some sand! Create tracks by running the sand scrapers over the smooth sand. Flip the scraper over for more unique patterns.
- Experience holding the scrapers at different angles; vertically or at various degrees.
- Not simply straight! Make spirals, swoops and swirls in the sand with the scrapers.
- Scrape again! Scrape over already scraped designs. See what other patterns you can make. Observe the changes.
- Trace those scrapers! Smooth out the sand surface. Trace the scrapers into the sand with the end of a pencil. If you look closely, some of the shapes look like parts of the human face! A mustache, an eye...the possibilities are endless!

Here are some other ideas:

- Scrape some paint! Cover an entire sheet of paper with a thin coat of paint. Tip: use a sponge to apply the paint. Run the scrapers across the paint to create fun visual effects. Check out Roylco's **R5451 Paint Scrapers** fc more scraping ideas.
- Trace the shapes! Create fun shapes with markers or pencil crayons on paper to make interesting designs.
- Write wacky words! Use the edges of the scrapers as ruler guidelines to write wacky messages.
