## Wee Kid Fingerpaint Paper



Encourage children to explore creativity while making their own self-portrait! Explore anatomy, texture reproduction, color recognition, dexterity and more.

### Ideas:

! • **Make a realistic self-portrait!** Have students draw their face on the shape with crayons, markers or pens and dress the shape up using fabric or patterned paper.

• **Explore human anatomy.** Children can draw bones on the back of the shape and vital organs on the front. When complete, have them label each bone and organ and use the shapes as a study guide.

• **Recreate important people in history!** For example: Christopher Columbus, Benjamin Franklin and Thomas Edison.

• **Illustrate characters from a classic story** then use the characters as a visual display when it's story time.

• **Make a special kid chain.** Have students decorate their kid shapes and take or glue them all together to for a chain. Hang the finished chain a border around your classroom.

• **Reinforce color recognition!** After children paint the kid shapes, hold them up in front of the class and have students identify the colors used in each design.



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
