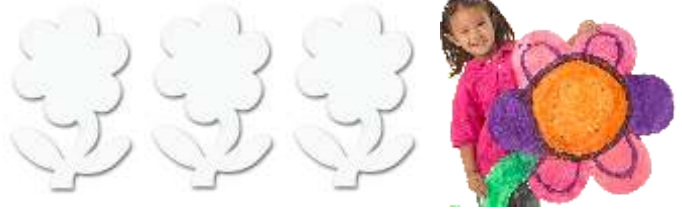

## Big Huge Finger Paint Flowers

Display your creations!

- Create a garden scene on the wall with your different flowery creations.
- Use the flowers as a teacher's decoration for your door.
- Tape them to the window for a great springthemed classroom decoration.
- For an "All About Me" activity, have the children put their name and picture in the center of the flower and decorate it with things they like. Then, bunch the flowers together on the wall for a class bouquet full of information. Perfect for parent/teacher night!
- When decorated, these make a great statement when posted throughout the school hallways.
