Bright Buttons

Bright Buttons are colorful, and sized so that children's fingers can easily handle them. They are great for sewing, stringing, counting, sorting and gluing.

Here are some ideas:

Make a bracelet! thread buttons onto a pipe cleaner. Leave some free space on both ends to twist together around your wrist.

String up a necklace! Cut a length of yarn 28" (70 cm) long. Anchor your yarn down by taping one end to your work surface. Thread the other end through one of Roylco's **5601 Plastic Lacing needles**. Select a button and thread the needle up through one hole and down through another. Try color coordinating or sequencing the buttons. Carefully remove the tape and tie the two ends together.

Sew up a design! Arrange buttons in interesting patterns or pictures and sew onto T-shirts, jackets, hats or shoes.

Create a math project! Use **Bright Buttons** to help students learn to count, or create patterns with shapes or colors.
