## Color In Masks





Design colorful masks and put on a play!

We've designed a simple mask shape and used a special type of perforation rule to cut it so it stays securely in the backer sheet. This design works especially well with rubbing plates. Lay the sheet over one of Roylco's plastic plates and rub with the tip or side of a crayon or colored pencil. Once your rubbing is complete, gently tear out the mask and poke out the holes on either side of the mask. Thread a chenille stem (not included) through one of the holes and twist to secure in place. Repeat with another chenille stem and the other hole. Once in place, bend the chenille stems so they loop over the ears. This is a more comfortable way for younger children to wear masks.



Tip: To create overall designs on your masks use Roylco's Optical Illusions, Maze, Textile, Animal Prints, Texture, Cultural or Geometrically-inspired designs.

To relate your masks to specific classroom themes, try Animal, Leaf, Bird, Fossil or Bug rubbing plate designs.

To make great rubbings, start by taping the rubbing plate onto a work surface to prevent slipping. Tip: Tape plates on inexpensive clip boards so students can use the clip to hold the paper in place. Lay the mask sheet over the plate and rub with the side or tip of a crayon. Pencil crayon and pastels work well, too.

If you don't have access to rubbing plates, use regular crayons, markers or pencil crayons to create designs. Rubber stamps and collage materials work well too!

Once the masks are designed use them as part of dramatic play or language activities. Research the history of Carnival or Mardi Gras and put on your own classroom celebrations.
