Bug Bodies

Build beautiful bugs with whimsical wings using Roylco's **Bug Bodies**!

Simply photocopy our wing patterns or create some of your own. Then cut wings out of tissue paper, Roylco's **R15212 Color Diffusing Paper**, wallpaper or patterned paper for cool, creepy crawlers!

Instructions:

1. Choose a **Bug Body**, tissue paper cut into a 4" (10 cm) square and a wing pattern.
2. Make copies of the wing pattern or design your own!
3. Fold the tissue paper in half. Lay the wing pattern over the tissue paper, color diffusing paper or patterned paper. Make sure the center of the wing is against the folded edge of the tissue.
4. Carefully cut out your bug wings.
5. Fold the bug wings fan style from the top down and insert them into the slot in the **Bug Body**. Fan out the wings. Be careful not to tear the tissue paper.
6. Cut a pipe cleaner in half and insert it into the head of the **Bug Body** for antennae. If you want, make the antennae curly by twisting the pipe cleaner around a pencil.
7. Use glitter glue, highlighters, markers or crayons to draw patterns on the wings.
