




Dinosaur Rubbing Plates are a dynamic way to combine educational learning with the fun of artistic expression. As children study different dinosaurs and their skeletal outlines, they can express what they've learned with imaginative artwork. Or, try one of the cool art projects below!


Before you get started tips:


- Use crayons, chalk, pencils, colored pencils, or finger paint. Hint: Jumbo-sized crayons for little hands work well.
- Rub crayons and chalk sideways for better impressions.
- · Work on hard flat surfaces.
- · Experiment with different papers.
- Tape the stencils down to a table for smaller children.
- Make a stamp with washable markers. Write on the lines of a rubbing plate and press onto a piece of paper. Clean with a soapy washcloth. Build a dino cave with cave paintings: Make dinosaur impressions on a long sheet of brown package paper. Hang the paper around a desk or small table which is turned on its side. Allow children to "explore" their dino cave. Use R5507 Dip & Print Dinosaurs to add dinosaur paintings to the "cave" walls!
- Create large moveable dinosaur skeletons! Create a clear dinosaur skeleton image from a Dinosaur Rubbing Plate. Use an overhead projector to enlarge the dinosaur image and project the image on a large sheet of poster board. Use a marker to draw the outline of the dinosaur skeleton on the poster board. Carefully cut out the moveable parts of the dinosaur. (Head, tail, legs, etc.) Use brass fasteners to connect the body parts together. Hang your dinosaur from the ceiling to create a dinosaur world!
- Travel back in time with a dinosaur mural. Use an empty bulletin board to create a dinosaur mural for your room. First make rubbings from each dinosaur plate. Cut out each rubbing. Then, use R15333 Botanical Cuts, R15259 Flower Paper, R52025 Dinosaur Fold Ups, and R15240











Dinosaur Paper to create a dinosaur habitat. Place dinosaurs in various places throughout their habitat. Instruct children to make up a story about traveling back in time to live with the dinosaurs!

■ Design a dinosaur shadowbox! Paint the inside of a small box to represent a prehistoric world. Then, use clay to create a volcano in the back of the box. Hint: R2114 Colored Rice works great for lava or sand. Add Botanical Cuts and pipe cleaners for vegetation, and hang cotton balls for clouds.

Make rubbings of dinosaurs and decorate them. Paste the rubbings onto poster board. Cut out dinosaur shapes and arrange in your shadowbox!

Publish your own dinosaur notebook! Study a different rubbing plate and the dinosaur it represents each day. Write down the information you learn in the pages of a notebook. Use Dinosaur Rubbing Plates to make impressions on typing paper. Use markers and crayons to fill in the lines on your impressions. Glue impressions in your notebook under the reports you've written. Place all pages in a binder for display in your classroom library.
