Technique: Pop out the shapes from the different sheets. Ask students to choose one of the 12 design cards and use the different shapes to create the image they see. The cards are graded by difficulty; one smiley face is an easy design, two is more challenging and three smiley faces is the most challenging design.

Ideas: Use the shapes to create textured collages! Simply use glue and Roylco's R5725 Goo Spreaders to create beautiful, textured collages. Use craft paper or decorate a flower pot for fun, take home art!

Explore descriptive language! Ask students to get into small groups. Assign each group a shape, or a sheet of shapes in one particular texture. Challenge students to come up with as many adjectives to describe their texture as they can in a set amount of time.

Create a mystery sensory box! Take a shoe box and cut a hole in the short end large enough for a child's hand to pass through. Tape or glue black construction paper over the opening so it acts like a flap. Place differently



textured shapes inside the shoe box. Challenge students to reach inside and feel the textures and describe to the class what they feel. Ask students to write down what they think is in the box. Once everyone has guessed, it is time for the big reveal!
