Mish Mash Mask Kit

If you ever just want to have fun and be silly, our Mish Mash Mask Kit is for you! We've gathered up lots of different shapes, colors and textures and mish-mashed them all into faces, hair, hats and accessories. There's only one rule here: use your imagination! Just grab some pieces from the kit and make the mask that makes you smile!

All you'll need to get started is some scissors and some glue. You can arrange your mask in just about any configuration you can think of. There are lots of facial expressions to choose from. Mix a pearly grin with fiery eyebrows, or make a grimace with cat eyes and a spaghetti nose. Why not add some rabbit ears to that?

Your kit comes with 6 sheets of fringe that you can use to make a silly mustache or beard, fuzzy eyebrows or stringy hair. Or, how about a fashionable scarf or fancy collar? Before you attach them to your mask, cut along one side with scissors to release the fringe shapes. You might even want to try cutting at different angles for even more interesting shapes. Then, trim them to the length that best suits your creation. You can keep the other side connected to help with gluing. When adding the glue, be sure to apply it to the dull matte (non-glossy) side for best results.

If you'd like to put a hat on your mask, you'll find several shapes that you can mix and match. There's a stocking cap, a fascinator hat, and a mixture of crowns and brims that you can jumble



up. There are also hat accessories, like feathers, bows and buckles, some flower shapes and even a Sheriff's star.

Part of the fun in making your Mish Mash mask is using your imagination to think of a silly name for your character. How about Sir Citrus Ice-Blaster, or Autumn Aqua Berry? Who is your character? Where does he or she live? Are they from another planet? Do they have super powers? Take some time to write it down, and then share the story of your character with your class!
