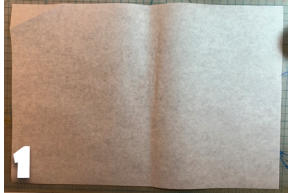


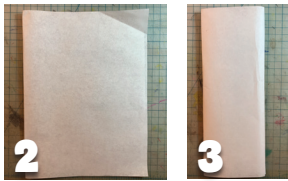
Paper Tie Dye

Bring the funky fun of classic tie dye techniques to our Color Diffusing Paper! When it comes to tie dye there are numerous techniques to produce a wide variety of effects. For this project we're going to create a repeating sunburst pattern. Here's how you do it:

Grade Level: Elementary
Time: 1 Hour (plus dry time)
Difficulty: Medium
Clean Up: Soap & Water



Step 1
 Lay the paper flat.



Step 2
 Fold in half.

Step 3
 Fold in half again.

Step 4
 Pinch the paper and pull it up in 2 to 3 places.

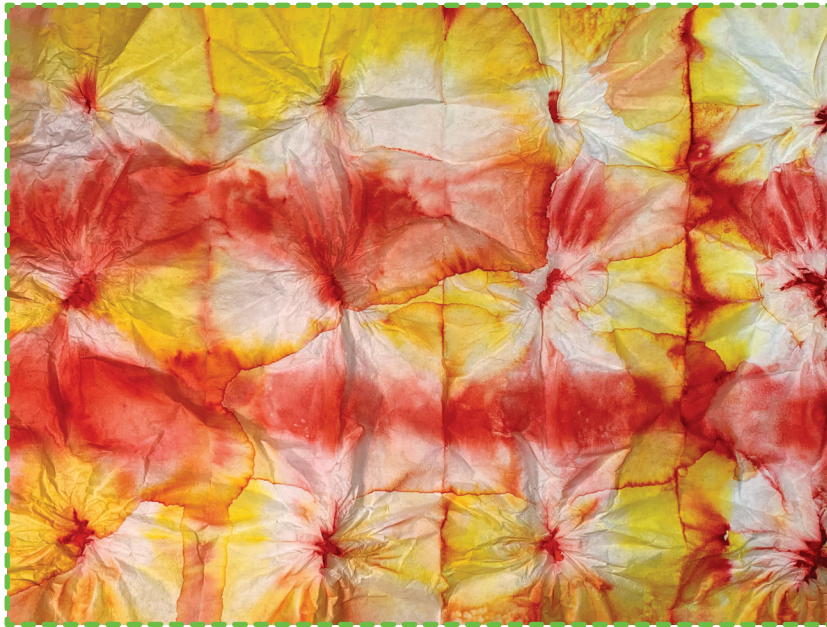
Step 5
 Wrap the pinched places with a rubber band.

Step 6
 Using water and liquid watercolors, paint the edges of the paper. Then paint the spaces between pinched places. Then add some color to the tops of the pinched places.

Step 7
 Let dry. Repeat as often as desired.

Step 8
 When the paper is completely dry, carefully remove the rubber bands and fold the paper out flat.

Use your tie dye creations to assemble cut out shapes in a hip collage, or simply hang them up to add color to any room!

 Color Diffusing

 liquid watercolors
 rubberbands
 Roylco Paint
 Pipettes (R5449)
 and/or brushes
 water
 misting bottle
 paint brush
 paint pipettes



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
