Animal Paper

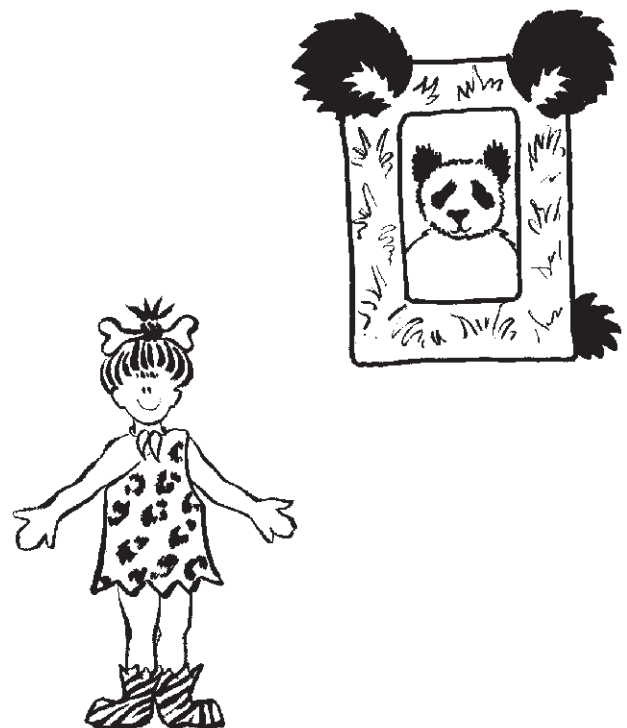


Explore the animal kingdom with beautifully designed papers representing popular animals. Use animal motifs to add an exciting new dimension to traditional paper crafts such as origami, collage, paper dolls and greeting cards, or try these great crafts:

File facts in fantastic animal folders. Start with a regular file folder, or cut folders out of tag board. Each child can research and describe an animal—where it lives, what it eats, how big it gets, etc. Younger children can draw pictures while older students can write up facts. Decorate the folder with **Amazing Animal Paper**. Use it to cut out letters for the title, make a border, or illustrate the animal!



Join a jungle parade! Cut **Amazing Animal Paper** lengthwise into 1½" (4 cm) strips for a headband. Tape two strips together to circle a child's head. Cut out ears and tape them onto the headband. Tip: to make a stronger headband, paste prints onto poster board before cutting them out. Use remaining paper to make tails or cover hands and shoes with paws or hoofs. Add face paint to finish your costume and get ready to march! Growl, howl, stomp and stampede to music as you parade around the classroom.
