All Kinds of Fabric Paper



Design your own fashions with a huge variety of colors and textile patterns! Our All Kinds of Fabric Paper is easier to cut than fabric, but it's just as versatile. Perfect for young children because they can create and cut by themselves. Perfect for older children because they can express their creativity with as much detail as they want!

The fabric paper is perfect for making paper beads. Here's how:

- Cut the paper into long thin triangles. The wide base of the triangle will be the width of the bead and the 'height' of the triangle will determine how thick or 'fat' the bead will be. The longer the triangle strip, the fatter the bead! Consider starting with triangles that have a 1/2 inch base and go the length of the long (8 1/2 inch) side of the paper.

- Glue the 'wrong' unprinted side of the paper, with lots of extra glue at the tip and none at the base.

- Starting at the base of the triangle, roll the triangle around a drying rod, such as a straw, a pencil, or a skewer.

- Once the bead is dry enough to stay together, gently pull it from its drying rod and start on the next one!

Additional tips and ideas:

- Give your beads some shine by coating them with a varnish, or even clear fingernail polish, before removing them from their drying rod.

- Add dimension by layering two coordinating 'fabric' triangles, and roll together! Remember, the layer will add thickness to the bead, so you may need to adjust the length of the triangle.
