



# Lesson Plan:

## Make & Take Butterflies

Bring vibrant butterflies to life with this fun and engaging Make & Take Butterfly Art Activity using Roylco's Butterfly Ornaments Kit! Perfect spring and summer no-school days, this activity allows kids to explore color blending and creativity while building important fine motor skills.



### Activity:

1. Start by giving each participant a pair of butterfly wings from the kit. Using washable markers, let participants color their wings however they like! White space is completely ok (trust us).
2. Once ready, place the wings into the No Mess Tray and spray with water. Let the colors diffuse to create beautiful tie dye wings. Hang them up, if possible, and they will dry very quickly.
3. While you wait for the wings to dry out, take the included wax yarn and weave through the antennae hole. You can use a pen or pencil to make the antennae squiggly!
4. Now, fan-fold the dry wings and insert into the Bug Body. Once inside, carefully unfold to reveal your winged creation.
